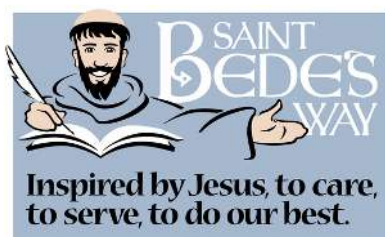
The St. Bede's Way
